



TARGA ADEIMF

Award eligibility

The Targa ADEIMF 2020 (ADEIMF Plate) award is assigned to the author (authors) of the best paper accepted for presentation at the ADEIMF 2019 Summer Conference. Together with the “Targa” a monetary award is assigned to cover submission fees for International Conferences and/or Journals, or any other activity connected with the internationalization of research. The costs are admitted to the award coverage if they have been paid from 12 months before the Summer Conference and up to 36 months after the Conference. All the costs have to be duly documented to be admitted for reimbursement within the award scheme.

A monetary award with the same aim is recognised also to the second and third classified papers.

Award amount

First classified paper: Targa ADEIMF and 2,000 euros.

Second classified paper: 1,500 euros.

Third classified paper: 1,000 euros.

The Award is intended per paper; therefore, in the case of multiple authors paper, the prize will be divided among them.

In the case of ex aequo, the Adeimf Board will distribute the prize without changing the initial budget.

Moreover, the rationale of the Award consists in allowing a widespread dissemination of the paper results within the international scientific community; therefore, all authors should receive a corresponding benefit.

Selection criteria for the best papers

The prizes are awarded to the first three papers classified according to the ranking of the refereeing activity for the admission to the ADEIMF 2020 Summer Conference.

Evaluating bodies

The evaluators are, indirectly, the same reviewers who must evaluate the admission of papers to the ADEIMF 2020 Summer Conference.

The ADEIMF Board is responsible for the final selection, in the event that non-convergent referee opinions were received; the same applies to papers that reach an equivalent evaluation.
