**Research program:**

The research activity will concern one or more aspects related with the study of financial markets, the functioning of the financial system and its institutions, as portrayed as follows. With regards to the economics of financial intermediaries, the research activity will focus on the strategic, managerial, organizational and operational models of financial, banking, pension and insurance intermediaries; as well as the organization and operation of the payment system and securities markets. Furthermore, it will deal with the characteristics and techniques of banking, insurance and securities transactions, the valuation and pricing models of financial instruments, the management models of financial and real estate assets and the optimization of asset-liability combinations, and the efficiency of the financial system and markets. From a methodological point of view, the research activity will rely mostly on empirical analysis and applied research methodologies.

**Didactic activities provided for by the contract, including integrative and service didactics to students, and research activity characteristics:**

For this position the expected teaching workload (comprehensive of teaching, supplementary teaching activities and services to students) is 350 hours for the full-time commitment regime. The commitment for official teaching in bachelor and master courses must be 90 hours. The researcher is required to fulfil the program of activities defined on a yearly base by the Department in compliance with the rules and procedures of the University of Bergamo concerning teaching duties (DR. Rep. n. 85/2017, prot. n. 24761/1/3, of February 20, 2017). The courses included in the teaching load will be both in Italian and in English, in undergraduate, graduate and post-graduate programs of the Department of Management related to the scientific sector 13/B4 - Economics of Financial Intermediaries and Corporate Finance. In addition, the candidate is expected to be involved in mentoring and supervising students at the undergraduate and graduate levels for the preparation of their bachelor or master dissertation. The candidate is also expected to be involved in the Department organizational duties and in the organization of the Department's courses.
